Ingredients

Cane molasses, monocalcium phosphate, dicalcium phosphate, concentrated separator by-product, corn distillers dried grains, magnesium oxide, vegetable oil, calcium carbonate, manganese sulfate, rice hulls, zinc proteinate, zinc sulfate, selenium yeast, copper sulfate, manganese proteinate, manganous oxide, copper proteinate, brewer's dried yeast, zinc oxide, cobalt proteinate, vitamin A supplement, vitamin D3 supplement, vitamin E supplement, mineral oil, ethylenediamine dihydroiodide, cobalt carbonate and calcium iodate.

Usage Guidelines

Placement: Place containers in areas that achieve desired supplement intake.

Relocation: Once acceptable intake levels have been achieved, the containers may be moved to underutilized pasture areas to improve grazing distribution and forage utilization.

Accessibility: A minimum of two (2) containers may be necessary in each lot or pasture to ensure proper accessibility.

Quantity: Feed at the rate of one container for every 20-30 head of mature animals. Cattle and bison typically consume between 0.3 and 0.75 pound per head per day.

Monitoring: Self-fed consumption will depend on size of the animals fed, seasonal weather conditions, as well as quality, source and availability of other feeds.
